Band Lessons

Band Lessons are held once a week in the band room. Students meet in small groups to learn the technique of their instrument. *This is the heart of the band program. This is where students progress towards mastery.*

The Band Karate program is a motivational progress indicator. Students can achieve different “belts” by mastering and performing various songs in the book that demonstrate a specific concept. *Students receive a sticker and yarn tassel to signify which level they have achieved.*

Practice Logs

Practice logs are kept in the students band folder. They should be filled out every week and signed by the parents. Just like a sport, music skills have to be consistently practiced for mastery and improvement

Each week there will be a music note to be learned and memorized. Our goal is to have every band student able to read music fluently by the end of their Reiffton years.

We also use SCHOLOGY for band.

Eagle Block

Eagle Block is large band rehearsal. This is where we learn how our parts fit together to create the entire song.

Band students get dismissed EARLY at 2:30 to set up on stage. Rehearsal starts at 2:35.
